The following questions were raised by the members at the EGM and the responses from SCB were as follows:

	<b>Questions raised by members</b>	<b>Responses from SCB</b>
1.	What is the impact of minimum wage of RM1,500 as implemented by the government on SCB?	Only 20% of the employees are affected as most of them are paid more than RM1,500 per month. There was a 1.46% increase in salary based on the Minimum Wage Policy. Hence, the impact on the operating cost is very minimum.
2.	What is the worst scenario under the debt restructuring exercise?	SCB has met all the milestones under the debt restructuring exercise and the Group’s operation is on uptrend now.
